Parent feedback 2024



There were 59% responses to the survey sent in the summer, increase from 30% in 2023 and 27% in 2022

Our families said :-

95% said that communication was good

98% said their child was well looked after

96% said the school is well lead and managed

98% said their child was safe

98% said their child was taught well and made good progress

100% said their child

was happy

98% said they would recommend our school

33 families that had children with additional needs said they were met

98% said their child was safe	1 family said their child was not safe, this respondent also disagreed about the exchange of information, that their child was taught well, and that the school has high expectations, but they would recommend the school. 98% said their child was well looked after	1 family said their child was not well looked after, but this respondent agreed with all other statements and would recommend the school – they said "My child was always happy to be at nursery May be your outdoor was full of activities, woodlan trips".	

- Specifically, we are concerned about cold weather clothing. Sometimes, the children are only wearing T-shirts without jackets or jumpers, and it is quite cold outside, which can lead to them catching colds. We understand that it is difficult to ensure that all the children are dressed appropriately, but we would appreciate your attention to this matter First, I wanted to share some feedback about a couple of issues we've noticed. (3-5s)
 - I've mentioned before that my daughter needs help with wiping after using the toilet. Lately, she's been coming home complaining about her bottom hurting and not being clean, which actually led to an infection. We had to take her to the doctor and get a steroid cream to help heal her skin.
 - Also, during the winter, we've noticed that when we pick her up, she's often only wearing a jumper, without her hat, scarf, or gloves, even though we send her to school with them.
- However, I will encourage the school to device ways to reduce incidence of injuries
- I feel like there could be more learning in the 2-3 class. I get the learn through play but it doesn't seem like there is much opportunity to learn things like letters, numbers,

- We really appreciate all the feedback. The weather is closely monitored and there will be a clear message to the children with regards to their clothing choices in the outside space and we will encourage them to be making the right choices. We will continue to embed this across the school.
- Thank you for the feedback about toileting, we do monitor this closely and are sorry your child was ill.
- At home time, we encourage the children to gather their own belongings, this is a learning curve for the children and they are sometimes not successful in this. They are also learning to regulate their bodies as to whether they need all the warm weather clothes.
- We monitor accidents and injuries on a monthly basis to ensure there are no trends or issues, please do feedback to us if there is an issue so we can address this quickly.
- We follow a play based curriculum and monitor the milestones children are working at each term. We focus on songs, rhythm, rhyme, communication before the stepping stone to letters and numbers.

Comments about communication



- It has been very good people, good vocabulary and reliable
- The 2-3s team are brilliant teachers! My son was looked after so well. They both are so friendly and professional. The exchange of information and

communication

93% said the exchange of information was good

Parents said:-

- Sometimes at drop off/collection it can be difficult to talk to the member of staff because they are busy but apart from that everything else is perfect
- The key teacher wasn't always there when dropping off/picking up our daughter and we had no chance to talk to her, sometimes we wanted to talk to her but it was not easy to approach. We know there are different ways of communicating but didn't want to contact the office etc as the issue was only small
- Drop in session once a term to see how they are getting on in nursery (like a stay and play).
- Pick ups could be a bit better providing more info. Would be nice to hear about what my child does at nursery instead of just hearing "he's been fine all morning" or "had a great morning" and then bye
- There is potential for improving the amount of detail about his day at pick-up.
- Would be nice to have more feedback and communication
- Everything has been good I think it's difficult to speak with a staff member at pick up without other parents hearing the conversation: also no real update on my child's day is provided when I collect him. I rarely know if he's eaten lunch or what was provided
- There is just one more thing that would make the SEND class even more amazing and stronger: it would be beneficial for parents to know what children are learning each week, so we could complement and build on children's learning at home. Excellent staff taking care of children very well
- More information at drop off and pick up would be useful
- Maybe extra parent meetings
- The only thing that could be better would be communication within the team about the needs of a child, which sometimes may be slow (e.g. I mentioned toileting issues my son currently faces on a few occasions before it seems to have been discussed within the team). (3-5s)

We will:-

- We appreciate that pick off and drop off may seem difficult to talk to a member of staff, however, we aim to rotate staff on the doors and gates through out the week. If any time you need to speak to a member of staff, just ask, however big or small the question will be, and we will aim to help or offer an appointment or phone call.
- If you need to arrange a time to talk to a staff member, just email the office who can help organise a mutually convenient time.
- We hold termly stay and play sessions, often at the end of the term to celebrate, do look out for these dates in the Newsletters and on email communication.
- As a maintained school, we have set pick up/end of session times, we appreciate this may seem 'less personal' than if you have previously been at a Day Care or other setting. We have a large number of children leaving at the same time, so a 1:1 handover is not possible. We ask parents to assume that their child has eaten lunch unless we tell them otherwise.
- When parents need to talk to us, we will look to find a private space in one of our meeting rooms if that is appropriate and we can meet ratios in the classroom.
- We will share weekly learning with parent so notice boards outside each classroom gate so that parents can build on this at home.
- More information at drop off and pick up would be useful
- Our parent meetings are termly, which is in line with school expectations, we would love to offer more, but this takes staff away from their role in th classroom and interacting with children



Comments about Tapestry

Parents said:-

- More information on tapestry and drop off would have been useful
- I believe the exchange of information regarding child's progress can be improved much better, the frequency of updates can be increased at tapestry, my child has previously attended pre- school in a different location where daily tapestry updates were provided. Also I believe a word about the day cloud help during collection time.
- More information on tapestry and drop off would have been useful It can be hard to catch the teachers to speak to sometimes, however pickup and drop off times are busy and I understand
- I love the updates on tapestry but do feel like they could be a little more regular
- Kindly request you to provide the access to Tapestry
- More tapestry would be helpful or an idea of what they are learning/ themes each week so we can support at home

We know how much our families love to receive Tapestry updates, however, we have to prioritise the interactions that our staff make with our children in the classroom. Tapestry updates, taking images and writing the observations take time away from the classroom to do this, therefore, we have reduced the amount we share with parents to monthly. We appreciate that if your child has been in a day care setting, this may feel very different. Our priority is communication and interaction with your child. In the September Newsletter, it was outlined how we use Tapestry and what you can expect. We do love parents to also give us a 'thumbs up' or comment when you have seen the post, to make all the administration worth while. Tapestry is also great for you to 'spark up' a conversation or interaction with your child.

Comments about Parent Meetings



- We valued the parent meetings, where the discussions have shown a good understanding of our son's needs and strengths and have given us some additional ideas and strategies to use at home.
- Parents meeting were helpful, I also appreciate that you're sharing pictures via Tapestry
- Meetings were very well planned, SENCo and key person extremely helpful, kind, caring and went about and beyond when anything needed to be changed or if additional support was needed.
