Healthy Start Vitamins

We now stock healthy start vitamins

Vitamins are essential nutrients that your body needs in small amounts so that it can work properly.

Even though you can get lots of vitamins from a healthy balanced diet, you still might not get everything you need at certain times in your life – such as pregnancy, a new mum or a small child. So UK health departments recommend that at these times you should take a supplement containing ecific vitamins to make sure you get everything you need

Healthy Start vitamins are suitable for vegetarians and halal diets, and free from milk, egg, gluten, soya and peanut residues. Pregnant women, women with a baby under one year and children from six months old to their fourth birthday on Healthy Start will get green Healthy Start vitamins coupon.

You can use your Healthy Start vouchers in exchange for the vitamins or they can be purchased for £2 for children's drops and £1 for women's tablets.

We are now able to hire out our state of the art breast pump for families.

your baby helps you to be able to give breast milk to your baby and avoid the expense and hassle of feeding formula. Using a breast pump allows you the flexibility to get back to work or school without your baby having to miss out on your milk.
