Termly Reminders

Covid-19 reminders

Please may I remind you that when you are picking up and dropping off children you wear a face covering or visor unless you are exempt from doing so.



At drop off/pick up, please can you continue to follow the different coloured footsteps and wait on the lines to ensure that we are keeping to the 2m social distancing rule. Parents need to ensure that any children or siblings with you stand and wait with you and do not run around the playground as this could increase contacts.

Contacting the office – if you need to talk to the office, we advise you telephone 01932 562225 or email on info@chertsey.surrey.sch.uk. If for any reason you need to talk to a member of staff, please email or telephone the office to make an appointment. Attendance – in order to prevent the spread of Covid-19, the following must be adhered to:-

- Anyone with symptoms must not enter the building and follow the current Public Health England guidance – please do not be offended if we ask you to come and collect your child if we suspect they are symptomatic and ask for you to get them tested. This is to protect all the children and staff in that bubble.
- You must inform the office immediately if your child is not attending and the reasons for absence so that any further spread of infection can be tracked and testing organised if appropriate.
- If we do not hear from you, we will contact you and ask for reasons for absence, this is part of our safeguarding procedures.
- Parents must inform us of any overseas holidays that are taking place, this is so that we can monitor the current Foreign Office guidelines with regards to isolation.
- At any time, if there is a positive case, all or part of the school may need to be closed, these decisions will be made through discussion with the Local Authority and Public Health England.

Reminder –

If your child develops symptoms in the 48 hours after their last day at Nursery, which results in a positive test result, please let us know so that we can contact trace your child's bubble. Therefore, if their last day at Nursery was Wednesday 31st March, if they develop symptoms on Thursday 1st or Friday 2nd April - please email the office on info@chertsey.sur-rey.sch.uk. This email address will be monitored during the holidays.
